Dear Mr. Kisiel:

Rural Development has re-reviewed the application items received for the above project. The Township and the project have been found eligible.

For planning purposes only, we have revised our records to show that the assistance recommended by Rural Development is now a loan in the amount of \$1,325,000 and a maximum 45% grant of \$1,125,000 at the intermediate interest rate with an applicant cash contribution of \$50,000. It is estimated that the cost per user will exceed \$71 per month. This is a preliminary amount based on current assumptions and regulations.


We expect loan and grant funds could be available for this project within 24 months.

Our State Engineer will be sending the review comments of the environmental report and preliminary engineering report when they are received. Request to publish environmental notices or the receipt of engineering reviews are not an indication of the availability of funds or when they will be available. You may respond directly to our State Engineer, Andy Granskog.
